

## **COPING MECHANISM**

Coping Mechanism is an exhibition featuring the work of Sujin Kim and Paul Wallington. Kim and Wallington shared a studio at HBFK but paint in different ways — Kim's work is abstract, Paul's figurative. Coping Mechanism is thus a dialogue between two friends, and two ways of painting.

Kim uses nature as her primary source of inspiration. Her work appears as if its in microscopic detail, or from a telescopic distance. Of something either too close to or too far to know what it is. A simulation of the observable universe.



Both painters use oil paint as a kind of coping mechanism, distorting how the world appears as a way of understanding it.






















Looking for Magenta. 2023








